### Mumford Council Soccer Challenge

All Boys and Girls ages 10- 14 are invited to participate in the local level competition for the 2008 Knights of Columbus Soccer Challenge. The local contest will be held August 23, 2008 10 Am to 2 Pm at Balmer School in Northbridge Ma. Winners will progress to district and State contest and International awards are presented by The International Knights of Columbus located in New Haven CT.

The Soccer Challenge is a competition designed for players to demonstrate the most basic of soccer skill- the penalty kick. Each player will be allowed fifteen shots on goal from the penalty kick line 912 yards from the goal. The goal is divided into five scoring zones. The upper corners are worth 20 points  
The lower corners 10 points and the middle of the goal 5 points.
