

NYSA Player Placement Program Summary



For Coaches, Parents and Players review

- **What & Why:** An updated process to provide fair, objective and non-biased assessment of players that enables proper team assignment. Divisional placement (1, 2, or 3) will be based on technical skills, tactical play, physical ability and psychological maturity. Players will accelerate skills development and remain motivated when matched with other players at the proper level. Maintaining player motivation, reducing burn-out at older age brackets and increasing team competitiveness are goals.
- **How & When:** Post season paper evaluations are completed by head coaches twice a year. This will be complemented by an open field evaluation to be held in June each year. The result will be used to determine Fall season placement and to make minor adjustments going into the Spring season.
- **Who:** For Fall 2010, all players who are eligible for U10 & U12 age levels will be required to attend the open field evaluation in June. All players, U10 thru U16, will be evaluated by their head coaches at close of Spring and Fall seasons.
